**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF STAFF COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 13TH
FEBRUARY 2018 AT 3.30 PM IN THE STAFF COMMON ROOM OF RIE,
BHUBANESWAR**


Prof. P. C. Agarwal, the Principal spoke a few words and mentioned about the proposal by V.C., Utkal University for establishment of study centre for north-eastern states in Utkal University campus.


The Vice-Chancellor asked the faculty members to give their self introduction and interacted individually regarding the academic achievements of one and all. He also gave a short note of his achievements.

He discussed on certain issues and advised the faculty as listed below:

- Regular seminar session need to be held in the institute for one hour duration and Ph.D. scholars may be encouraged to participate in the seminar.
- Need of Advisory Committee for Ph.D. Scholar(s) to carry out their research work effectively.
- Prof. S. K. Das raised the issue of the faculty being deprived of acting as guide for Ph.D. degree in Science education. In this context, V.C. replied that there should not be any restriction by the SRC regarding this and said that without a specific subject education has no meaning.
- The term "Pre-Ph.D. course" is not correct to use for the course work being carried out presently. On the contrary it is an integral part of the total Ph.D. programme.

The meeting concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Dr. R. R. Sethy, Joint Secretary, Staff Council.
