The Institute will hold Walk-in-Interview on 06-09-2017 at 10:00 a.m. in the Staff Common Room for engagement of **Assistant Professor in Education** (Physical Science Education, Language Education (Odia) & ICT Education) & at 03:00 p.m. for **Assistant Professor in Zoology** purely on contractual basis with a consolidated remuneration of Rs.45,000/- per month, for the Academic Session 2017-18 as per need. The tenure of engagement is up to 30-04-2018 or till the regular incumbent(s) join the post(s), whichever is earlier. The Contractual engagement will confer no right to claim the post on regular basis.

**Essential Educational Qualifications for Assistant Professor:**

- i. Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) in the relevant subject for Lecturer/Assistant Professor conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET in the relevant subject.
- iii. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) to this Clause, candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the U.G.C. (Minimum standards and procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or the subsequent regulations if notified by the UGC, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent position in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

“Provided further, the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil/Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bylaws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-


- a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only.
- b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners.
- c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted.
- d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal.
- e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D work.

(a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-chancellor/Pro-Vice-Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs)/Dean (University instructions).”

- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

**Desirable Qualification:** B.Ed./M.Ed. or equivalent for all posts of Assistant Professor. Preference will be given to candidates with specialization in Methodology for the post of Assistant Professor in Education.

**Note :-** Retired faculty members below the age of 70 years may also attend the Interview. Remuneration for retired faculties will be fixed as per NCERT/Govt. of India norms.
