The mandatory reservation of (SC-15%), (ST-7.5%), (OBC-27%), and (PwD-5%) and (EWS-10%) will be followed as per the Government of India Norms. Ten percentage (10%) of seats for EWS category will be provided to the eligible candidates over and above the existing permitted strength. The reservation of seats will be distributed to all the States and Union Territories according to the merit and availability of candidates.

### Reservation Policy

## Reservation Policy

As per the Government of India rules candidates belonging to certain categories are admitted to seats reserved for them based on relaxed criteria. The following reservations are available SC 15%, ST 7.5%, OBC 27%, PwD 5%,EWS 5% Candidates applying under reservation quota will be considered only on the basis of the lists notified by the Government of India and the category certificate/ PwD certificate in the format approved by the GOI and issued by the competent authority. OBC candidates will have to attach a certificate from competent authority stating that he/ she does not belong to Creamy Layer.

Sub:- Introduction of 27% reservation for OBCs for admission in courses of RIEs regarding.

Sir,

The proposal for introduction of 27% reservation for OBCs for admission in courses of RIEs has been approved by the MHRD which is reproduced below:-

All RIEs are required to reserve seats for OBCs excluding the 'Creamy Layer' under the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006 in the courses and programmes of study offered by the RIEs through general admission procedure without reducing the existing number of unreserved seats. This would in effect translate into 54% expansion in capacity. Owing to the 27% reservations for the OBCs, proportionate increase in seats in SCs/STs is necessitated by 15% reservation for the former and 7% for the later on the increased capacity.

(ii) The RIEs may provide reservation in phases over three years in keeping with physical, financial or academic constraints.

The intake of students in the existing courses will be increased by 13%, 30% and 54% respectively in 2008, 2009 and 2010. For new courses the initial intake will not be altered.

27% reservation for OBC students in all RIEs would be distributed over a period of three years with 9% reservation being introduced in the 1<sup>st</sup> year (2008), 18% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year (2009) and 27% in the 3<sup>rd</sup> year (2010)

Since all RIEs have released admission notification for 2008-2009, revised admission announcement may be released as early as possible.

I am directed to refer to UGC letter no. 81-1/2019(CU) dated 18.01.2019 (copy enclosed) wherein reference is invited to O.M no. 12-4/2019-U1 Dated 17.01.2019 regarding reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) for admission in Central Educational Institutions and to inform that Council is following UGC guidelines in respect of service matters / pay scales of its Academic staff. The reservation policy in admissions is to be followed as per MHRD OM No. 12-4/2019-U1 Dated 17.01.2019 from next academic year from 2019-20.

Hence in view of the above, it is requested to kindly get the data prepare for raising the seats by 10% in various courses offered by RIEs with financial implication and logistic support needed to implement the reservation. Further, it is also requested to check the validity of the affiliation of the courses offered to avoid any hardship which may cause to students. Special emphasis is to be given by RIE, Bhopal as Nodal Agency for Common Entrance Exam – 2019.

Minutes of the Meeting of CEE-2022 held on 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 at NCERT, New Delhi

The meeting was presided by Prof. Dinesh Prasad Saklani, Director NCERT and attended by the following members/faculty/officials:

The following points were discussed and recommended for the approval:

**Admission Forms and Prospectus Related**

1. Eligibility of State of Domicile may be the same as of previous Common Entrance Examination including CEE-2021.
2. Eligibility of State of Domicile:
  - a. The Candidate should select the appropriate State/UT against which he/she are seeking admission. As a proof of eligibility of State/UT for admission, the candidate has to compulsorily produce any one of the following documents:
    - i. Evidence of having passed the qualifying examination from the State/UT as given in the advertisement and published in the CEE-2022 Website <https://cee.ncert.gov.in>
    - ii. In case of legal guardian / parents is an employee of State / Central Govt. / Govt. of India undertaking / Autonomous bodies the latest certificate of place of posting in the State / UT.
    - iii. A domicile certificate from the competent authority of the concerned State /UT.

*Candidates can produce any one of the document of choices (i), (ii) or (iii).*

3. Admission to M.Sc.Ed. offered by RIE, Mysuru and, B.Ed.-M.Ed. offered by RIE, Bhopal will be on all-India basis and, rest of the other courses will be restricted to region-wise state quota.

4. A candidate can apply for more than one Course/Programme for admission with a single registration with a single payment as per their eligibility (as specified in the Eligibility Criteria in the CEE Portal).

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination up to two years back i.e., 2020, 2021 and appearing/appeared in 2022 can apply for B.Sc.B.Ed./ B.A.B.Ed./ M.Sc.B.Ed.

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6. There is no restriction in the passing year to apply in B.Ed., B.Ed.-M.Ed. and M.Ed.
7. Each RIE will prepare advertisement/notifications and information brochure as per status of their courses, according to the NCTE latest guidelines and will provide to CEE Cell, RIE, Bhopal latest by March/April, 2022.
8. Each RIE can update their respective state quota matrix according to the Census 2011. For undergraduate courses like B.Sc.B.Ed., B.A.B.Ed. and B.Ed., the Seat Matrix will be revised. For States and UT's, the minimum number of seats will be 5 and 3, respectively, for each course. The respective RIE will modify the Seat Matrix and will be providing the same to CEE Cell, RIE, Bhopal before the publication of the Advertisement or latest by March, 2022.
9. The reservation for EWS will be as per the Government of India norms.
10. For reservation of Hyderabad-Karnataka under Karnataka reservation quota, data will be captured and provided to RIE, Mysuru for processing at their end.
11. There will be one seat for each course in all RIEs over and above the allotted quota for the nominated candidates of CTSA and they are exempted from appearing the entrance examination. RIEFA section will communicate to CTSA, regarding this.
12. Each RIE will advertise in their respective regions.
13. Number of seats will be offered to each state as per past practices and as per the reservation policy offered in the form. The course wise seats are mentioned below:

14. All India merit list of B.Ed. and M.Ed. will be shared with all RIEs to fill up their vacant seats after exhausting their own list, if needed, by consulting other RIEs admission list.

#### Entrance Examination Application Processing Fee:

15. Rs. 1,000/- for General/OBC Category and Rs.500/- for SC/ST/PwD and EWS Candidates.

- a. The expenditure chart justifying the fee structure is placed below in this minute for approval of the competent authority.

#### Centres for Examination:

16. Three Options will be given as the Examination Centres to Candidates. The 40 cities for CEE-2022 will be:

Ahmedabad, Ajmer, Berhampur, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Chandigarh, Chennai, Cuttack, Dehradun, Delhi, Ernakulam, Gangtok, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Jaipur, Jammu, Jorhat, Kanpur, Kavaratti, Kolkata, Leh, Lucknow, Mumbai, Mysuru, Nagpur, Panaji, Patna, Pune, Ranchi, Prayagraj (Allahabad), Port Blair, Raipur, Ranchi, Sambalpur, Shimla, Shillong, Silchar, Sri Nagar, UMIAM (NERIE), Vijayawada.

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17. RIE, Bhubaneswar will send details of 30 centers including Cuttack, Sambalpur and Berhampur to CEE-Cell Bhopal before second week of April, 2022.

18. Any addition or deletion of City/Centers may be allowed to CEE-Cell at the later stage depending upon number of registrations of the Candidates.

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19. The room rent for the KV's will be Rs. 2,000/- per room per day.
20. The room rent will be paid for the day of conducting the CEE-2022 examination, only. One more room rent may be provided to the Exam Centre which is used for Custodian Room, if claimed.
21. The honorarium for the Dy. Centre Suppl., One Office Asst. and Two MTs will be paid as per the prescribed rate for the arrangement of the CEE-2022, prior to the day of the CEE.
22. The honorarium for Observer for conducting CEE-2022 examination will be Rs. 2,500/-.
23. The honorarium for Invigilation for conducting CEE-2022 examination will be Rs. 1,500/- (including Travelling Expenses).
24. The honorarium for the Coordinator, NIE, New Delhi for distributing and collecting the examination material will be Rs. 2,500/- and for the supporting staff will be Rs. 1,000/- per person (maximum four persons).

**Scoring pattern:**

25. Sixty percent weightage from entrance examination and 40% weightage from our definitions of aggregate scores for all programmes.
26. Aggregate score will be defined as:
  - a. For B.Sc. B.Ed. and M.Sc. B.Ed.: Obtained marks of PCM out of Maximum marks of qualifying examination.
  - b. For B.A. B.Ed. obtained Total Marks of qualifying examination out of Maximum marks of qualifying examination.
  - c. For B.Ed. obtained total marks of qualifying Graduate degree examination out of the maximum marks of qualifying degree examination.
  - d. For M.Ed. obtained total marks of qualifying examination out of the maximum marks of qualifying examination. If, the qualifying examination is B.Sc.Ed./ B.Sc.B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed. Only, the obtained total marks of professional components out of the maximum marks in these components. If, the qualifying examination is D.El.Ed. with graduation, only the obtained marks out of the maximum marks in the D.El.Ed. examination will be considered.
27. Tie Cases will be decided by scores of Teaching Aptitude test. Further, tie will be decided on the basis scores of Reasoning, further tie will be decided on the score of English language.
28. Scoring pattern is 2 Marks for the right choice and -0.5 (Negative) for the wrong choice. Merit list will consider 2 digits after decimal with rounding off.
29. In case, the CEE is not conducted, then the merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the Qualifying Examination taking in to consideration the following points mentioned, below, for the various courses.

**a. For B.Sc.B.Ed. (Physical Sciences)**

1. Aggregate of PCM Marks of 12<sup>th</sup> will be considered first.
2. In Case of Tie, Mathematics marks will be added.
3. In Case of further Tie, Physics marks will be added.

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- b. For B.Sc.B.Ed. (Biological Sciences)
  1. Aggregate of PCB Marks of 12<sup>th</sup> will be considered first.
  2. In Case of Tie, Biology marks will be added.
  3. In Case of further Tie, Chemistry marks will be added.
- c. For M.Sc.B.Ed. (Physics/Chemistry/Mathematics)
  1. Aggregate of PCM Marks of 12<sup>th</sup> will be considered first.
  2. In Case of Tie, Physics/Chemistry/Mathematics marks will be added to the percentage of the subject for which the Candidates has applied for the masters course.
  3. In Case of further Tie, English marks will be added.
- d. For B.A.B.Ed.
  1. Overall Obtained Marks of 12<sup>th</sup> will be considered first.
  2. In Case of Tie, First Language Marks will be added.
  3. In Case of further Tie, Second Language Marks will be added.

**Seniority of passing the Qualifying Examination:** (e.g., if, one has passed in 2020 and other has passed in 2021, then the candidate who passed in 2020 may given the preference over the candidate who passed in 2021)

**Seniority of Age (Date of Birth):** After following the criteria No. 1, mentioned above, still the Tie exists than the candidate who born earlier than the other candidate may be given preference in the allotment of seat.

30. RIEs will provide one seat for each course B.Sc. B.Ed. and B.A. B.Ed., (RIE, Mysuru will also provide one seat for each course of M.Sc. B.Ed. i.e., Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics, and RIE, Bhopal will also provide one seat for B.Ed.-M.Ed.) over and above of their regular quota for NTSE awardees and Tibetan. The related data will be handed over to ESD, NCERT, New Delhi for verification and further processing of admission at RIEs in respective courses.

31. Each RIE will complete admission process as per their schedule of their affiliated University.

#### Eligibility for Admission in to Various Courses

##### Eligibility for B.A.B.Ed. Course

32. Candidates must have passed +2/Hr. Secondary/Sr. Secondary or equivalent examination in Science, Commerce or Arts streams with at least 50% marks in aggregate (relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST/PwD Candidates) in 2020, 2021 or appearing/appeared in 2022.

##### Eligibility for B.Sc.B.Ed. Course

33. Candidates seeking admission to Physical Science Group must have passed with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (PCM) (M stands for Mathematics or Statistics) and those seeking admission to Biological Science Group (CBZ) must have passed Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) (B stands for Biology or Biotechnology) at +2 level.

Candidates must have passed +2/Hr. Sec./Sr. Sec. or any equivalent examination recognized by University/Board with at least 50% marks in overall aggregate of qualifying examination (relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST/PwD Candidates). The qualifying examination should be recognized by the affiliated universities of the respective RIE.

35. Candidates who have passed +2 /Hr. Sec./Sr. Sec. or any equivalent examination in 2020, 2021 or appearing/appeared in 2022 only.

#### Eligibility for M.Sc. B.Ed. Course

36. Candidates seeking admission to Physical Science Group must have passed with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (PCM) (M stands for Mathematics or Statistics) at +2 level. M.Sc. B.Ed. Course is offered only in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics.

37. Candidates must have passed +2/Hr. Sec./Sr. Sec. or any equivalent examination recognized by University/Board with at least 50% marks in aggregate of qualifying examination (relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST/PwD candidates). The qualifying examination should be recognized by the affiliated universities of the RIEs.

38. Candidates who have passed +2/Hr. Sec./Sr. Sec. or any equivalent examination in 2020, 2021 or appearing/appeared in 2022, only.

#### Eligibility for B.Ed. Course

39. Candidates with at least 50% marks in Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's Degree in Sciences/Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with Science or Mathematics or in Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's Degree in Social Sciences/Humanities are eligible for admission to the programme (relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST/PwD Candidates). The Candidate should upload only the marks secured in the Degree Examination (Graduation) as Qualifying Marks.

40. Candidates with Bachelor's Degree in Science/Master Degree in Scienc/BE/B.Tech. (Science/ Maths) are eligible for B.Ed. (Science & Maths Group) and Candidates with Bachelor's Degree in Social Science/Humanities or Master Degree in Social Science/Humanities are eligible for B.Ed. (Social Science & Language Group), respectively.

#### Eligibility for M. Ed. Course

41. Candidates seeking admission to the M.Ed. Programme should have obtained at least 50% marks or an equivalent grade (relaxation by 5% for SC/ST/PwD Candidates) in the following programmes/courses from any University/College/Institute recognized by affiliating universities :

- B.Ed.
- B.A.B.Ed./B.A.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed./B.Sc.Ed.
- B.El.Ed.
- D.El.Ed. with a Bachelors degree in Arts/Science (With 50% marks in each)

42. Any misrepresentation of facts (Qualifying Marks, Domicile, Category, etc.) by the candidate will disqualify his/her candidature.

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### Eligibility for B.Ed.-M.Ed. (Integrated) Course

43. A postgraduate degree in Science / Social Sciences / Humanities / Commerce from a recognised institution with a minimum 55% marks or equivalent grade (relaxation by 5% for SC / ST / PwD Candidates).
44. The CEE-2022 may be held on 03<sup>rd</sup> July, 2022 (Sunday)
45. The Last date for submission of qualifying examination marks for applicants (B.Sc. B.Ed./B.A. B.Ed./M.Sc./Ed.) is 30/06/2022 and the result will be declared on 15/07/2022. Last date for submission of qualifying examination marks for appearing applicants (B.Ed./B.Ed.-M.Ed./M.Ed.) is 15/07/2022 and the result will be declared on 25/07/2022. At the time of counselling, the candidates have to produce the respective mark-sheet fulfilling their eligibility. (The last date of uploading the Qualifying Examination and the publication of the CEE- 2022 results may be extended, depending upon the publication of results of Qualifying Examinations for various courses.)
46. Any misrepresentation of facts (Qualifying Marks, Domicile, Category, etc.) by the candidate will liable to disqualify their candidature and NCERT will not be held responsible for that.


47. A committee will be constituted with convener from CEE-Cell for this purpose. The committee will review (if required), recommend and develop the following items:
  - a. Syllabus for CEE (separate for +2 level, graduation level and for admission in M.Ed.) and it will be published for the information of Candidates too in the CEE portal.
  - b. For all the groups, areas to be tested: Language Proficiency, Teaching Aptitude, and Reasoning Ability.
  - c. Out of 80 questions, Language Proficiency in English 20 questions, Teaching Aptitude 30 questions and Reasoning Ability 30 questions weightage will be given.
  - d. Medium of Test Booklets – only in English and Hindi.
  - e. No. of test items - 80, Time Duration – 120 minutes.
  - f. No. of test booklets – Only one set of booklet will be prepared for each group.
  - g. Separate Questions will be prepared for the following groups:
    - Group-A: Test items will be of +2 level
      - i. B.Sc. B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed./M.Sc.Ed. (RIE, Mysuru)
    - Group-B: Test items will be of graduation level
      - ii. B.Ed.
      - iii. B.Ed.-M.Ed.(Integrated) (RIE, Bhopal)
    - Group- C: Test items will be of graduation and professional education level
      - iv. M.Ed.


The committee will develop question items confidentially. Honourarium and the rate per item development will be paid to the experts/item developers as per the NTSE rate/any other norms approved by competent authority.


48. As per previous years pattern (2019), an examination cell will be set up at RIE, Bhopal.

49. An Examination Cell will be set-up at NCERT, New Delhi for the CEE-2022 comprising of DS-RIEFA, US-RIEFA, SO-RIEFA and one Dealing Assistant. They will be paid a one-time honourarium at the rate of Rs. 5000/-, per per person.
50. For dispatching CEE kits, materials, etc. to examination centers courier services, like Blue-Dart or other such reputed/reliable Service Providers may be hired.
51. Centre expenditure will be borne as per CEE-2019 or Centre specific (like KV) norms.
52. In CEE-2022, Officials/Faculty member may be allowed to travel by local/non-local taxi and flight as per the govt. of India/NCERT norms as per the when-ever required with the permission of Principal of respective RIEs. However, in all the cases of air travel, the air tickets are required to be booked through three authorized travel agents only, viz., M/s Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd., M/s Ashoka Travels & Tour OR IRCTC Official Portal. Booking of Air Tickets other than authorized agent is not permissible. (The booking of Air Tickets through website of airlines, any other agencies like Yatra.com, Makemytrip.com, Paytm flights, etc. or any other unauthorized private agent is not permissible). Officials/Faculty members may avail the hotel facilities as per their entitlements. The budget is given in expenditure chart for approvals.
53. All expenditures for conducting CEE-2022 will be met from CEE-2022 fund. However, immediate expenditures will be met by the concerned RIEs and will be reimbursed from CEE-2022 fund later. Air Ticket booking should be as per NCERT norms.
54. All RIEs are required to send the CEE-2022 expenditures audited bill (with vouchers) to RIE Bhopal within one month of the date of the examination for the payment.
55. For the preparation of results, Principal will depute nodal officer along with one more faculty member and merit list will be signed by Principals of respective RIEs before declaration of results, if needed.

**Question Paper/Printing Related:**

56. A firm will be selected through technical & financial bids (two-bid system) through Limited Tender process for confidential/secretary printing of question paper booklets, OMR, attendance sheet, etc. and their packing & delivery to states/UTs of respective cities, scanning of OMR and result processing, if required as per the norms.
57. No. of copies of test booklets need to be printed-as per the number of applications + 10% to 15% extra.

**Examination System Related:**

58. NIC, Bhopal/RIE, Bhopal will develop required software applications (online applications, fee payment, allotment of exam centres, generation and downloading of hall tickets, entry of marks, uploading of entrance marks, verification list, rank generation as per the required criteria etc.) and the website for the conduct of CEE-2022.
59. NIC, Bhopal/Delhi will be provided with three programmers for a period of 12 months for fine tuning the required software applications and execute the process involved in CEE-2022.
60. One-time payment for NIC will be paid for the CEE-2022 related tasks or as per its requisition.
61. Keeping in view of workload involved in this huge and complicated exercise, CEE-Cell will be operated with round year schedule.
62. Keeping in view of these requirements, CEE Cell Bhopal will appoint on contractual basis, one consultant (@ Rs. 45,000/per month/NCERT Norms), one System Analyst (@ Rs. 40,000/per month) three Programmers (@ Rs. 35,000 per month), two

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Computer Assistants (at Rs. 25,000/per month), One Office Attendant (at Rs. 20,000/per month) or as daily-wages (as per the rates for the period of 12 months). Expenditure will be met, immediately, from the Council/Institute/CEE fund and will be adjusted from CEE funds, later on.

63. Infrastructural requirements to be provided to CEE Cell at RIE, Bhopal. Expenditure will be met, immediately, from Council/Institute/CEE fund and will be adjusted from CEE-2022 funds, later on.
64. CEE-Cell room at RIE, Bhopal will be provided with necessary computer and related technology equipment, furniture, telephones, and other relevant materials for conducting CEE-2022. Expenditure will be met immediately from the Council/Institute/CEE fund and will be adjusted from CEE-2022 funds, later on. Expenditure on refreshment/tea/snacks may be met from the CEE fund.
65. RIE, Bhopal will execute purchase of technology equipment, furniture, etc., required for CEE-2022.
66. All the CEE related work assigned to the staff/officials of NCTERT is mandatory and binding on them to perform.
67. The decision regarding taking the NIC Services for the Web Portal Development may be decided after reviewing the software developed by our programmers and the space for hosting provided by NIC, Delhi to the NCTERT Main web site. If the NIC hosting is not available, in time, the space may be hired from other Service Providers/previous service providers, as per the suggestions of the NIC, Bhopal which suits to the software to be deployed.


**Examination Preparedness Related (Observers):**


(The Process to be followed for the CEE-2022 for Orientation of Observers; and Distribution & Collection of Confidential Materials and OMR Sheets)

68. Observers from RIE, Bhopal (Nodal Observers) will be deputed to other RIEs, and NIE to orient the rest of the Observers in the respective Institutions in consultation with the Nodal Officer (s). The Nodal Officers of RIE, Bhopal will be paid honourarium of Rs. 2500/- for the day of CEE, excluding the DA/TA.
69. Semi-Confidential documents and keys will be handed over to the Observers of Examination Centers by the Nodal Observers at the respective constituents.
70. All the Observers should reach their respective examination centers one or two days prior to the date of examination forenoon and meet the Centre Superintendent. Both of the Centre Superintendent and the Observer should meet the Custodian Bank Manager (if applicable) so as to ensure receipt of confidential documents in the morning of examination date.
71. The Centre superintendent will receive the confidential document from the Manager of the custodian bank at 6.00 AM on the date of examination in the presence of the Observer.
72. The Observers at the examination centre is required to check and confirm the allotment of Man-Power, Seating Arrangement, Police Protection and all the other issues mentioned in the Observer's Check List. Towards the end of the examination, the Observer is required to send paper-wise attendance to the National Coordinator, CEE-2022.
73. After the examination, all the examination related materials, including Attendance Sheets, OMRs, Unused Question Papers, etc. should be packed in the presence of the observer. The Observers will collect these materials from the Centre Superintendent



    - a.ii. In case of legal guardian / parents is an employee of State / Central Govt. / Govt. of India undertaking / Autonomous bodies the latest certificate of place of posting in the State / UT.
    - a.iii. A domicile certificate from the competent authority of the concerned State / UT.

Candidates can fill any one of the choices (i), (ii) or (iii).

3. Admission to MSc.Ed. and B.Ed.-M.Ed. (Integrated) will be on all India basis and all other courses will be restricted to region wise state quota.

## Admission Forms and Prospectus Related

1. Eligibility of state of domicile may be the same as of CEE-2016.
2. Eligibility of States:
  - a. Select the appropriate State /UT against which you are seeking admission. As a proof of eligibility of State/ UT for admission, the candidate has to produce any one of the following documents:
    - i. Evidence of having passed the qualifying examination from the State/ UT as given in the advertisement
    - ii. In case of legal guardian / parents is an employee of state/ central govt. / Govt. of India undertaking/ Autonomous bodies the latest certificate of place of posting in the State/ UT.
    - iii. A domicile certificate from the competent authority of the concerned state/UT.

*Candidates can fill any one of the choices (i), (ii) or (iii)*

3. Admission to MSc Ed. and BEd. M.Ed. (Integrated) will be on all India basis and all other courses will be restricted to region wise state quota.

6. There is no restriction in the passing year to apply in B.Ed., M.Ed., and B.Ed.-M.Ed. (Integrated)
7. Each RIE will prepare advertisement/ notifications and information brochure as per status of their courses, according to the NCTE new guidelines and will provide to RIE Mysore latest by 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2016.

28. Candidates seeking admission to M.Sc. Ed. (Physics/ Chemistry /Mathematics) must have passed with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (PCM) (M stands for Mathematics or Statistics) at +2 level.
29. Candidates must have passed +2 / Hr. Sec./ Sr. Sec. or any equivalent examination recognized by University/ Board with at least 50% marks in aggregate of qualifying examination (relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ ST/PH candidates). The qualifying examination should be recognized by the affiliating university of RIE Mysore (University of Mysore)
30. Candidates who have passed +2 / Hr. Sec./ Sr. Sec. or any equivalent examination in 2015, 2016 or appearing /appeared in 2017 only will be considered.

**Eligibility for B.A. B.Ed.**

31. Candidates must have passed +2 / Hr. Secondary/Sr. Secondary or equivalent examination in Science, Commerce or Arts streams with at least 50% marks in aggregate (relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ ST/PH candidates) in 2015, 2016 or appearing /appeared in 2017.

**Eligibility for B.Ed.**

32. Candidates with at least 50% marks in Bachelor's Degree and /or in the Master's Degree in Sciences/ Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with Science or Mathematics or in Bachelor's Degree and /or in the Master's Degree in Social Sciences/Humanities are eligible for admission to the programme (relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ ST/PH candidates).

**Eligibility for M. Ed.**

33. Candidates seeking admission to the M.Ed. Programme should have obtained at least 50% marks or an equivalent grade {relaxation by 5% for SC/ST/PH Candidates} in the following programmes / courses from any University / College / Institute recognized by affiliating universities:
- B.Ed.
  - B.A.B.Ed./B.A.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed/B.Sc.Ed.
  - B.El.Ed.
  - D.El.Ed. with a Bachelors degree in Arts/Science (With 50% marks in each)

**Eligibility for B.Ed.-M.Ed. (Integrated)**

34. A postgraduate degree in Science/Social Sciences/Humanities from a recognised institution with a minimum 55% marks or equivalent grade (relaxation by 5% for SC/ST/PH Candidates)
35. Last date for submission of qualifying examination marks by the candidate is 15<sup>th</sup> June 2017. There will no due date for submission of qualifying examination marks for the candidates applying for B.Ed., M.Ed. and B.Ed.-M.Ed. (Integrated). At the time of counseling they have to produce the respective mark-sheet fulfilling their eligibility.



## Test Paper Related

36. Director NCERT will constitute a committee with convener from CEE-Cell for this purpose. The committee will review, recommend and develop the following items:
- Syllabus for CEE (separate for +2 level, graduation level and for admission in M.Ed.) and it will be published for the candidates too.
  - For all the groups, areas to be tested: Language Proficiency, Teaching Aptitude, and Reasoning Ability.
  - Out of 80 questions, Language Proficiency in English 20 questions, Teaching Aptitude 30 questions and Reasoning Ability 30 questions weightage will be given.
  - Medium of Test Booklets - only in English and Hindi.
  - No. of test items-80, Time Duration-90 minutes.
  - No. of test booklets-Only one set of booklet will be prepared for each group.
  - Separate Questions will be prepared for the following groups:
    - Group-A
      - B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.A.B.Ed. / M.Sc.Ed. (Mysore)
    - Group-B
      - B.Ed.
      - B.Ed.-M.Ed.(Integrated)
    - Group- C
      - M.Ed.
  - Group-A test items will be of +2 level,
  - Group-B test items will be of graduation level.
  - Group-C test items will be of graduation and professional education level.
37. The committee will develop question items confidentially. NTSE rate/ any other norms approved by competent authority will be applied for payments.

## Conduction of Examination and post examination process

38. As per the last year pattern, an examination cell will be set up at NCERT HQ for CEE-2017. US RIEFA, SO RIEFA and one Programmer may be associated with CEE-Cell at NCERT HQ.
39. Towards expenditure for items related to examination process (like paper printing and delivery at centers, OMRs printing, Examination Kits preparation, distribution to centers etc.) payments will be made as per CEE-2016 rates or CBSE-2017 rates.
40. For CEE for dispatching examination kits to examination centers etc. courier services like Blue-Dart may be hired as per last years' pattern.
41. Centre expenditure will be born as per CEE-2016 or CBSE-2017 or Centre specific (like KV) norms.
42. In CEE-2017, Officials / Faculty member may be allowed to travel by local/ non-local taxi and by air with any Air Lines when-ever required with the permission of Principal of respective RIEs. Officials / Faculty members may avail the hotel facilities as per their entitlements. The budget is given in expenditure chart for approvals.



43. All expenditures for conducting CEE-2017 will be met from CEE-2017 fund. However, immediate expenditures will be met by the concerned RIEs and will be reimbursed from CEE-2017 fund later. While traveling other than Air India, payments will be made with pending approval from IFD, MIIRD. Air Ticket booking should be as per NCERT norms.
44. All RIEs are required to send the CEE-2017 expenditures' audited bill (with vouchers) to RIE Mysore November 2017 for the payment.
45. For the preparation of results, Principal will depute nodal officer along with one more faculty member and merit list will signed by respective RIEs before declaration of results.

### QP Printing Related

46. Agency for Printing of test booklets may be hired confidentially as per last year pattern and either with CEE-2016 rates or CBSE-2017 rates.
47. No. of copies of test booklets need to be printed-as per the number of applications + 10 to 15% extra.

### Examination System Related

48. NIC Bangalore will develop required software applications (online applications, fee payment, allotment of exam centres, generation and downloading of hall tickets, entry of marks, uploading of entrance marks, verification list, rank generation as per the required criteria etc.) and the website for the conduct of CEE-2017.
49. NIC Bangalore will be provided with three programmers for a period of 3 to 6 months for developing the required software applications and execute the process involved in CEE-2017.
50. Keeping in view of workload involved in this huge and complicated exercise, CEE-Cell will be operated with round year schedule.
51. RIE Mysore will also keep the option of continuing to use NIC Jaipur software applications. However the final decision will be taken by RIE, Mysore in consultation with the Director, NCERT. In such a situation Prof. P. K. Chaurasia will technically coordinate with NIC Jaipur to take the process of conducting CEE-2017 forward. If required he may also be supported with human resources.
52. Keeping in view of these requirements, CEE Cell Mysore will hire one consultant (@Rs. 45,000/ m), six computer assistant (@Rs. 16000/m) (four will engaged with help line for six month) and one daily-wager (as per the rates) for the period of 11 months. Expenditure will be met immediately from the council fund and will be adjusted from CEE-2017 funds later on.
53. Infrastructural requirements to be provided to CEE-Cell at RIE Mysore and Examination Cell at Delhi HQ. Expenditure will be met immediate from Council fund and will be adjusted from CEE-2017 funds later on.
54. CEE-Cell room at RIE Mysore will be provided with necessary computer and related technology equipment, furniture, telephones, and other relevant materials for conducting CEE-2017. Expenditure will be met immediately from the Council fund and will be adjusted from CEE-2017 funds later on.
55. RIE Mysore will execute purchase of technology equipment, furniture etc., required for CEE/2017.
