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

Wel	come to Members of the Management Committee:	

At the outset, Prof. A.K. Mohapatra, Prof.& Head, Department of Extension Education, Regional Institute of Education, Bhubaneswar welcomed Prof. K.B.Rath, Vice-Chairman of the Managing Committee of the Institute and thanked him for sparing his valuable time to preside over the meeting. He also welcomed Prof. Samson Maharana and special invitees of the Managing Committee and thanked them for sparing their valuable time in spite of their busy schedule. Then Prof. Mohapatra

requested Prof. K.B. Rath to address the members and conduct the proceeding as per agenda.

Introductory remark of the Chairman:

Chairman of the Management Committee meeting Prof. K.B. Rath, Principal and Vice-Chairman of the Managing Committee, RIE Bhubaneswar welcomed and expressed his thanks to all the members and Special Invitees to be present in the Managing Committee meeting.

Agenda-1: Confirmation of the minutes of the 51st Management Committee meeting & Action taken

After a brief discussion on the minutes of the 51<sup>st</sup>Managing Committee meeting, the Vice-Chairman invited the members and Special Invitees to offer their comments if any changes are required in the minutes. Since there were no comments or suggestions for change, the Vice-Chairman declared that the minutes were confirmed as circulated. Prof. K.B. Rath presented the action taken on report as follows:

In the 51<sup>st</sup>Managing Committee meeting, Prof. Pranati Panda had suggested to bring out innovative lesson plans for Pre-service teachers. As per the suggestion, attempts were made to modify lesson plans. He also informed that institute is trying to implement Choice Base Credit System and as starting point, curriculum of M.Sc. (Life Science) Ed. programme is revised. It was also informed that Multi-cultural programme was modified with necessary changes in the format of lesson plan, observation etc. He discussed about reformulation of 4-year integrated B.A. B.Ed. Programme Curriculum. Institute is in the process of revising 2 Year M.Ed. programme as per NCTE guidelines.

As per suggestion of the 51<sup>st</sup>Managing Committee meeting, we are organizing grandparents' meeting with class teachers. 50<sup>th</sup> Managing Committee also suggested for skill development programme and Institute is organizing soft skill development programmes through an initiative known as 'Panela Kadam'.

To improve the quality of in-service training programme, DEE is planning to develop a module on comprehensive framework for in-service teacher training programme specifying the modality and process. It is also discussed about the need for improving skills such as communication and reflective thinking which are essential to work as reflective practitioner. In continuation of the discussion Prof. S Moharana enquired about the possibility of mapping skills of students so that it would help in introducing new courses in pre-service teacher education programme of the institute as the skill mapping exercise would bring out existing gap among student teachers' kills. In addition to conventional teaching skill development programme he suggested to think about programmes to motivate student teachers to plan lessons using internet resources and ultimately developing student teachers as better humane. In this direction, he suggested for development of thinking skills such as creative thinking among students of the institute. Principal reiterated that skill orientation requires basic foundation and is very important to think about developing these skills with available infra structure. Prof Satapathy mentioned that some of the skills are integrated in the classroom whereas Prof Animesh Mohapatra suggested that Science and Maths Kits prepared by NCERT are to be utilized in this regard. Prof B.N Panda suggested the need for equipping students to think creatively and reflectively and he also mentioned about the significance of developing Pedagogical Content Knowledge (PCK) and Technological Pedagogical Content Knowledge (TPCK) among students.

### Agenda-2: Report on the activities of RIE, Bhubaneswar:

Prof. B.K. Parida, Dean of Instructions and Head, DESM presented different activities of Regional Institute of Education, Bhubaneswar for the year 2014-15. This Institute provides pre-service training programmes to students from the states of Odisha, West Bengal, Bihar, Jharkhand, North East States and A&N Islands. The Institute also provides in-service and extension education to teachers and other functionaries from all the states under this jurisdiction. He informed this institute runs the following programmes:

- Four year integrated B.Sc.B.Ed. (PCM/CBZ)
- Four year integrated B.A.B.Ed
- c. Two year B.Ed.(Arts/Science)
- d. One year M.Ed.
- e. One year M.Phil. (Education)
- f. Two Year M.Sc.(Life Science) Ed.
- g. Diploma Course in Guidance & Counselling (DCGC)

It was also informed that recently M.Sc.(Life Science)Ed. programme was revised according to Choice Base Credit System for the next Academic session. He mentioned that RIE, Bhubaneswar is one of the Nodal Centers for Pre-Ph.D. in Education Coursework of Utkal University, Bhubaneswar.

Discussion followed was mainly based on opportunity provided to research scholars as nodal research centre in Education. Prof S. Moharana enquired that whether institute encourages faculty to do research and publish research articles in various journals. He suggested to publish an Annual or Biannual research journal with ISSN number to encourage faculty of the institute to publish research articles and take measures to sustain and maintain quality of the articles in the journal.

Prof Parida informed that a number of schools are approaching the Institute for campus placement of students.

The Special invitees as well as members of the Managing Committee expressed their satisfaction and recorded their appreciation over the result and activities of the Institute for which the contributions of the faculty members were acknowledged.

#### Agenda-3: Report of the activities of D.M. School

Mr. A. Mishra, Headmaster of the D.M. School appraised different activities of the D.M. School. He presented the student's enrolment of different classes during session 2014-15 and also informed the members about the spectacular performance of the students of different classes of DM School in CBSE and AISSE Examination of 2014.

#### Agenda-4: Minutes of the SCC & IAB meeting

The State Coordination Committee Meetings for the State of West Bengal was held an 21st November 2014. The programme proposals were identified in the SCC meeting for the year 2015-16 for the state of West Bengal and A & N Island.

The 13<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Institute Advisory Board of Regional Institute of Education, Bhubaneswar was held on 12<sup>th</sup> January 2015 at 10:30 A.M. in the Staff Common Room of the Institute.

### Agenda-5: Programme proposals of RIE, Bhubaneswar for 2015-16

Dr. A.K. Mohapatra, Prof. & Head Department of Extension, Education, informed that 30 programme proposals were received and they were approved by IAB to be conducted by different departments of the Institute for the session 2015-16. The Programmes were categorized as follows:

It is also mentioned in the meeting that courses such as wealth management could be offered as it is one of the necessary skills required by all.

Sub:- Permitting Teacher Interns from RIE for internship in JNVs.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to above stated subject, it is to recall that some request have come from RIE for permitting students interns in JNVs for internship for a period of 30-45 days. Permissions have already been given. It is further presumed that necessary instructions have been issued to the JNVs regarding the same with detailed guidelines on how to handle the internship programme in the JNVs. However, some of the guidelines which may be of good use are being communicated herewith for supporting the said activity in JNVs.

- Permitting interns in the JNV may be viewed as an opportunity to mentor the future generation of teachers. Through this our regular teachers will get the chance to train the future generation of teachers in all aspects of life cycle of the teachers in Navodaya Vidyalaya System.
- The regular teachers in the NV should be able to hand hold the intern in encouraging them to learn all the aspects of teaching tearning testing and evaluation, residential components, co-scholastic activities, Self study classes, remedial teaching and expertise in the curricular framework and concepts.
- Teacher interns will be permitted to teach the concepts in those subjects as permitted by the teacher concerned.
- 4. Teaching by the interns will take place in the presence of teachers of INV, in the classroom, on a co-teaching mode so that the regular teacher may supplement and complement the required factors. Therefore, the subject teachers should invariably be present to ensure that teaching fearning process inside the class takes place at the desired level and the components of formative assessment are also followed as per CBSF norms.

5. Similarly the experience of design of testing and evaluation will also be imparted to the interns while such processes are carried by the regular teacher in the vidyalaya.

6. Interns may be allotted all the duties as applicable to the teachers inside the vidyalaya except escort duty related to journey of the students outside the campus as this involves higher order of responsibilities. In all activities. duties like incharge activities/MOD/House of Master/Programme Incharge/Morning Incharge/additional responsibilities the assistance of the interns may be Assembly/Mess obtained to give them the training of understanding the processes. degree of freedom given to the interns may depend upon the teacher who

7. To provide appropriate comforts to the intern students, it may be ensured that female interns are always attached with the female teachers.

8. The RO may device an appropriate report format for the report from the mentor teacher to the Principal in respect of performance of the intern students so that the intern will keep working fruitfully.

9. In view of the requirement of appropriate attention on the intern by the vidyalaya authorities it may be good to restrict the number of interns for

school only up to 5 per JNV at a given point of time.

10.All rules of conduct as applicable to employees of the vidyalaya are applicable to Interns. It will also be essential to get an undertaking from the individual intern regarding their proper conduct during the tenure of internship, duly countersigned by the authority of Parent Institute.

II.In case of any mal adjustment/mis-conduct by the intern/s in view of the residential nature of the JNVs, strict action shall be taken to return back the intern to the parent institution apart from initiating any other action as deemed fit in the interest of the vidyalaya. In any case the parent institution will be responsible to handle such events.

12. The Teacher Interns will deposit in advance the mess charges. Since all the interns will have the meals served to the students on regular basis, no special arrangements will be made on this account. Nor visiting interns demand for special treatment. Stay arrangements may be made as per availability in the JNV concerned. However, visiting faculties from RIEs may be provided accommodation in the Guest House, as per availability, on chargeable basis.
