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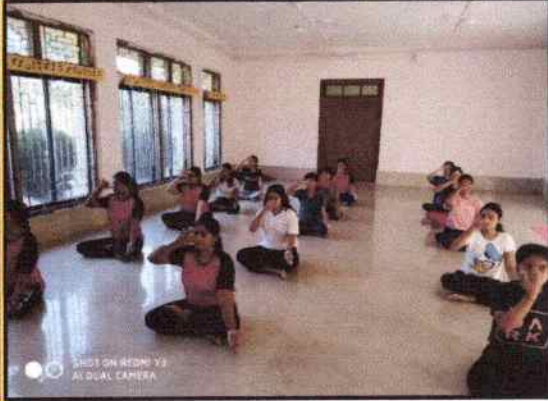
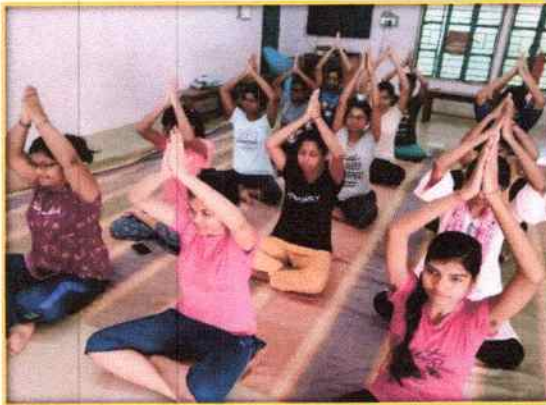
01. Celebration of days of National and International Importance: Spreading awareness

Celebration of International Day of Yoga:

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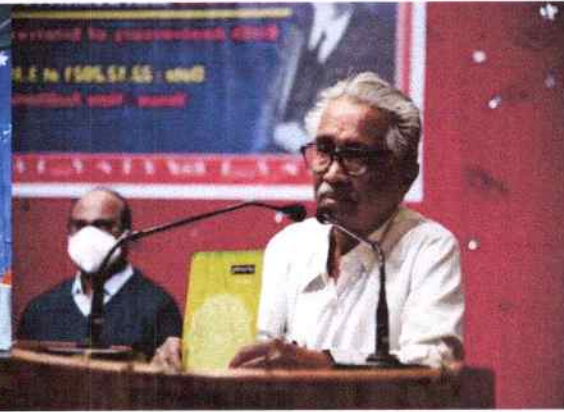
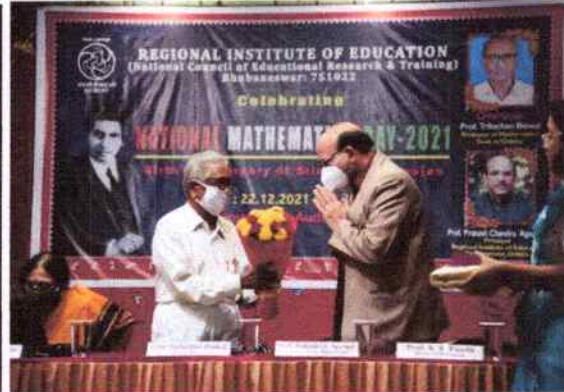
23 in 1931. They were hanged to death for assassinating John Saunders, a British police officer in 1928.

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
National Science Day

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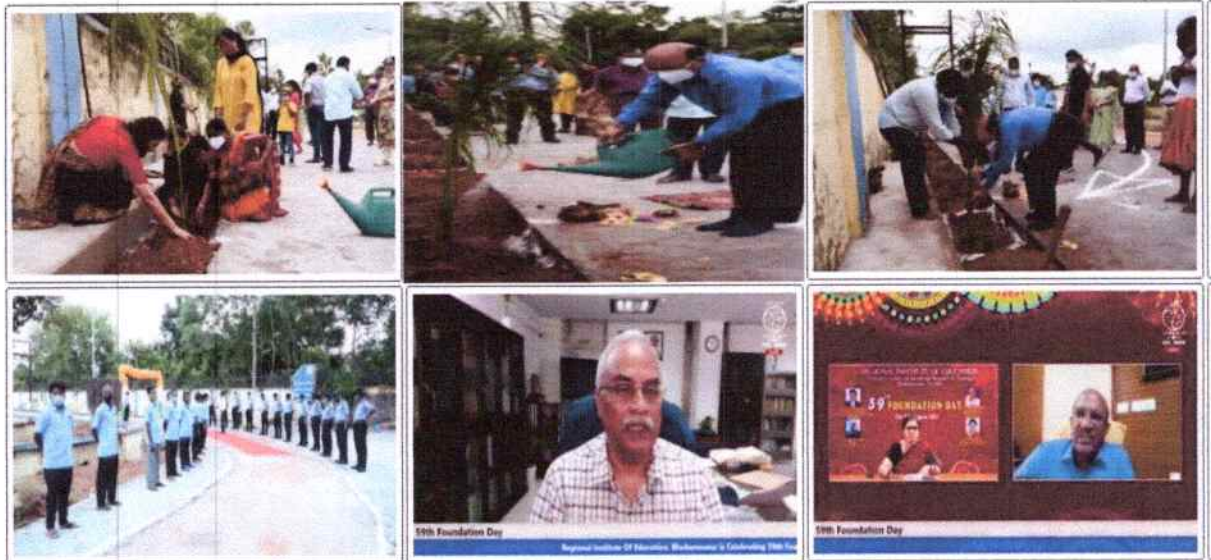
RIE, Bhubaneswar Foundation Day

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Republic Day Celebration

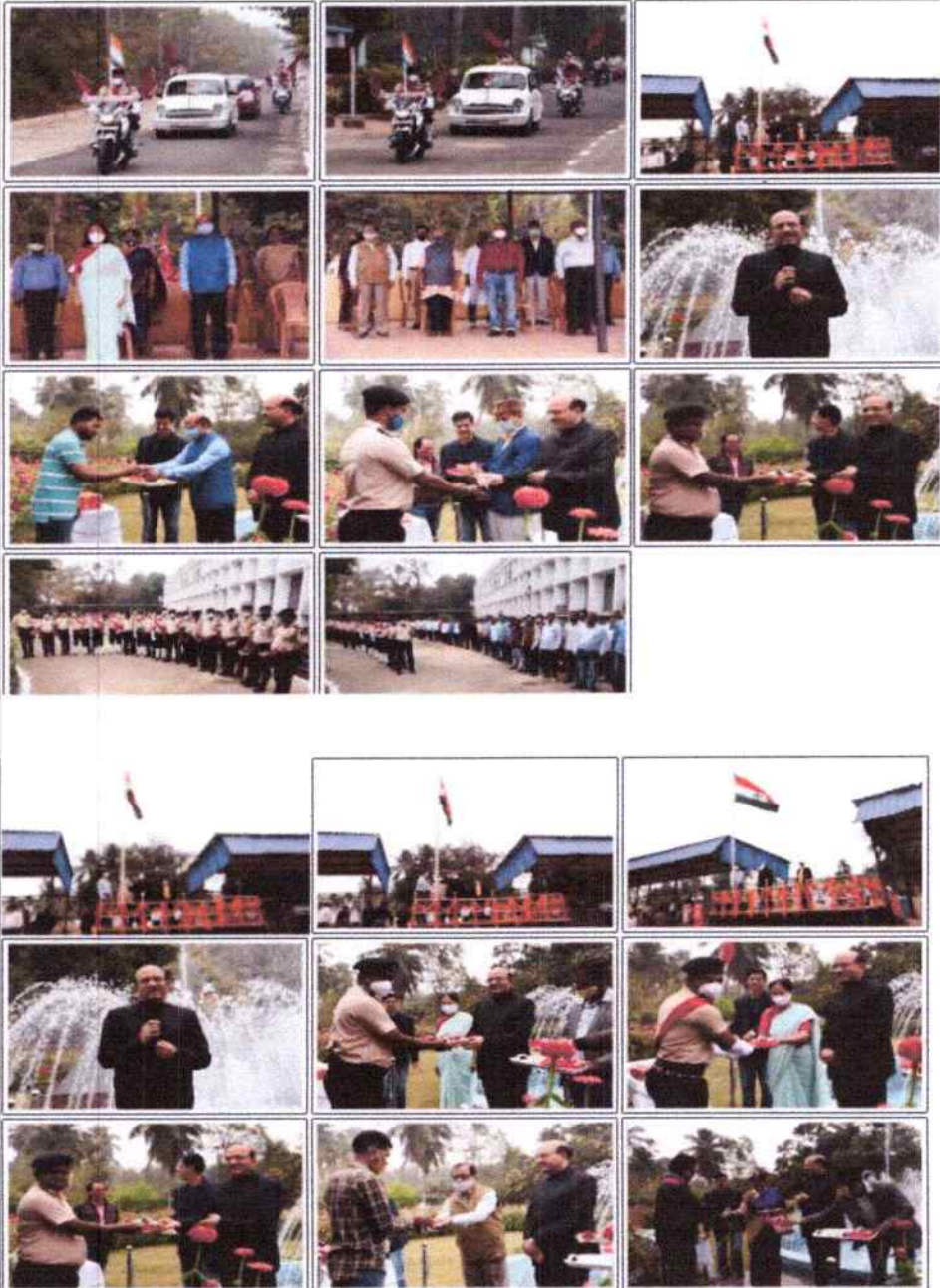

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02. Celebrating birth anniversaries of great leaders

Birth Anniversary of Bharat Ratna Baba Saheb Bhim Rao Ambedkar

Born on April 14, 1891, Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar is also known as the 'Father of the Indian Constitution' as he headed the committee which drafted the Constitution of India. A jurist and also an economist, he was posthumously conferred the Bharat Ratna, the country's highest civilian award in 1990, more than 30 years after his demise on December 6, 1956. Ambedkar Jayanti is being observed as a public holiday through the country since 2015. The Regional Institute of Education, Bhubaneswar organized a programme in the memory of 131st Birth Anniversary of B.R. Ambedkar.


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Birth Anniversary of Subhash Chandra Bose

Netaji Jayanti or Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Jayanti, officially known as Parakram Diwas (lit. 'Day of Valour'), is a national event celebrated in India to mark the birthday of the prominent Indian freedom fighter Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose. It is also celebrated annually on 23rd January every year in RIE, Bhubaneswar.




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Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti

Gandhi Jayanti is an event celebrated in India to mark the birthday of Mahatma Gandhi. It is celebrated annually on 2 October, and is one of the three national holidays of India. The UN General Assembly announced on 15 June 2007 that it adopted a resolution which declared that 2 October will be celebrated as the International Day of Non-Violence as he was a non-violent freedom fighter. He is also known as the "Father of The Nation" and this title was given to him by Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose for his relentless struggles for independence. 03. Swachhata Bharat Abhiyan

In this programme, awareness campaign was organised to bring motivation among students to be interested towards the work. The Swachh Bharat or Clean India is the


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mission which begins from the individual. This awareness triggers knowing one's responsibility and one's perception towards cleanliness of self and others as well as surroundings. Street cleaning and drain cleaning is very important to keep the surrounding clean as well as maintaining a healthy and hygienic life style. Use of toilets is one of the major concern of this developing nation to eradicate open defecation and emphasize on personal hygiene.

The main objective was to make people and children aware for cleaning the surrounding as well as maintaining cleanliness in daily activities. It's our duty to be clean first before making others aware of others. In village most of the people were not aware about Swachh Bharat, So this activity made people aware to maintain a hygienic lifestyle.

The main objectives of this programme are:

- To improve quality of life of people living in the rural areas.
- Motivate people to maintain sanitation in rural areas to complete the vision of Swachh Bharat by 2019.
- To motivate local working bodies (such as communities, Panchayati Raj Institutions, etc.) to make available the required sustainable sanitation facilities.
- Develop advance environmental sanitation systems manageable by the community especially to focus on solid and liquid waste management in the rural areas.
- To promote ecologically safe and sustainable sanitation in the rural areas.

Various Strategies followed are visiting the nearby villages, neighbouring areas and Basti areas, The materials used for awareness was only chart paper and colors for drawing posters and showing to the people. Videos were also used to make people aware about "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan" with help of YouTube. Slogans, Speech on Swachh Bharat mission, making people aware of importance of toilets, cleaning the streets and drain with the help of local people and using different types of dustbins for different types of wastes- biodegradable and non-biodegradable are few other strategies which were followed.



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Although the programme was of short duration, but still a noticeable change was observed in lifestyle of people of the villages. In one of the villages around 10 families put dustbin in front of their house for throwing waste. Two different dustbins were also set by the village committee in front of the temple. A good number of people supported the cause and appreciate the ideas. Some people also promised to use dustbin every day and to keep the village clean. There was notable cleanliness in the streets and back alleys of the village.

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
MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 31.10.2018 at 4.00PM IN THE OFFICE OF LIBRARIAN

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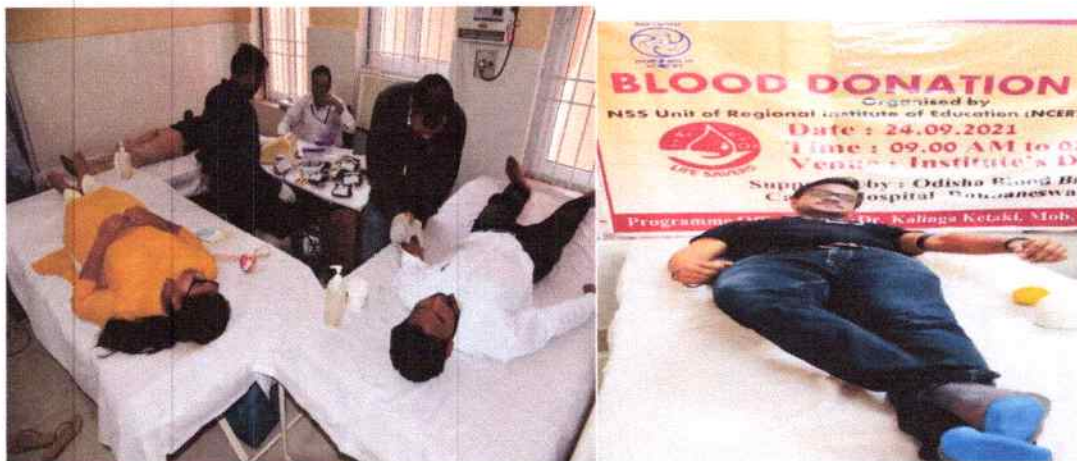

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National Service Scheme (NSS)

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

Institute have participated in the event. This programme was coordinated by Dr. (Mrs.) P.L. Negi.

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developments taking place in various subjects, disciplines and professions over time. Eminent Experts from different fields of knowledge have been invited to deliver lectures on different themes.

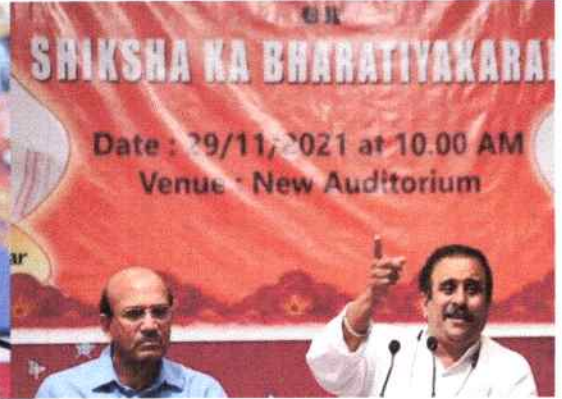
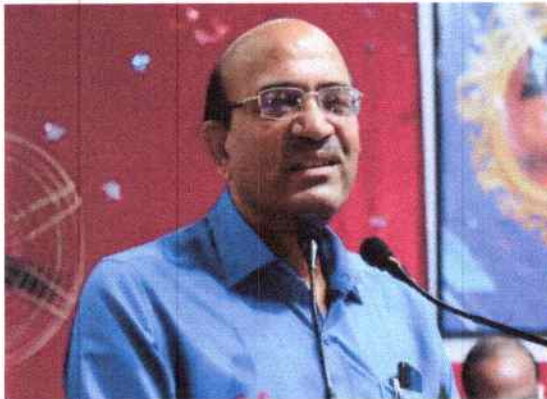

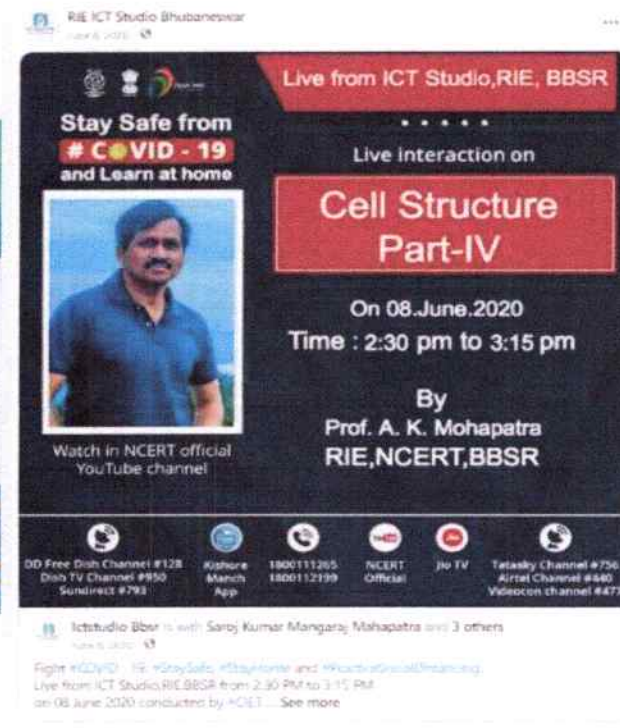
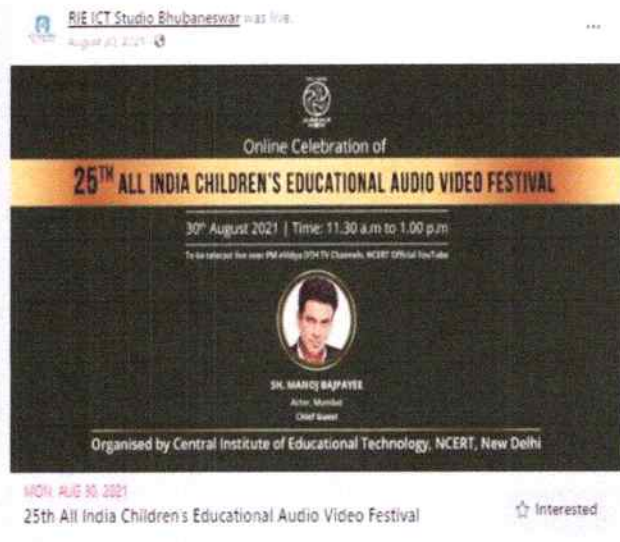
09. Digital India

Digital India program was launched by Honorable PM, Narendra Modi on 1st July 2015 to digitalize and create a knowledge economy in the country. For this, our institute has installed an OFC network in campus and office. This network extended to all students hostels, guest house and Demonstration Multipurpose School. Under digital India program, institute has developed three computer laboratory for the use of students and Staff. Our teaching and learning has been transformed by use of smart board and smart class rooms. As per the instructions of the CIET, our institute has developed econtents which are included in epathashala mobile app and PMeVidya program of Ministry of Education.

All our teacher education program has included ICT and it's applications in the curriculum and field engagement activities. Under digital India program, most of the

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official communications are made online and eoffice program is installed for administrative use.



10. Career Exhibition

Under the DCGC programme, every year career exhibitions are held at different places of field study. Career exhibition is a comprehensive tool to get a peek into the vast world of careers, professions and courses. Detailed and updated information about the diverse career opportunities is presented to a large group of students at the same time with the

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help of elaborate charts. The aim of organizing career exhibitions, also known as career day, is to orient the students to the various options that they have along with all the necessary information they would need to pursue the career of their choice. The trainees apart from guided self-learning and internship also engage in an intensive practicum phase and this event called the 'career exhibition' is also a part of one of the five practicums. It is a part of practicum 117 titled Collection, Management and dissemination of Information. The focus of this practicum is to bridge the gap between career information and students. As one of the components of an extensive guidance curriculum, this activity is another way of facilitating career awareness and exploration. The career exhibition was held at Kendriya Vidyalaya No. 2 Bhubaneswar on 12th & 13th September 2022 for the students of secondary and senior secondary sections. The career exhibition was organized by the trainees of Diploma Course in Guidance and Counseling of session 2022 from the Regional Institute of Education, Bhubaneswar.




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11. Educational Field Trip

This visit was supervised by Prof. Elizabeth Gangmei, and Ms. Sibani Dora (JPF). All 38 trainees were part of the field visit. The visit was undertaken with prior intimation to the authority of the two institutions and different department/sections of the visiting institutions were prepared to provide the necessary details by the concerned in-charges.

The first institution visited was Ali Yavar Jung National Institute of Speech and Hearing Disabilities which caters to the needs of persons with speech and hearing disability. The institute provides a varied number of services for the people facing hearing difficulties like providing pre-school and early childhood education, outreach and extension services, inclusive support, clinical services starting from audiology, speech pathology, special and inclusive education, psychological testing and counselling. The institute also offers a number of educational courses centred around special education like Diploma in Special Education (Hearing Impairment), Bachelor of Education in Special Education etc. It offers short time course as well like Refreshers' course for In-service teachers, Orientation to Health workers, training on Hearing Aid Repairing and ear mould making etc. Informative sessions were taken by Mr Lanu W Aimol (Assistant Director), Ms Biswamitra Mishra (Ear Mould Technician), Mr B K Dash (ESA Psychology) and others emphasising the need of special education and the services they offer.



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The second institution that was visited was Chetana Institute for Mentally Handicapped which is a special school for the children with intellectual disability. The organization named as 'Jewels International' was established in 1977 to perform social service, mass education, and public vigilance programmes. In the year 1985, the organization decided to work for the education and rehabilitation of children with intellectual disability. On 18th August 1985, this centre was started for identification of children with intellectual disability and now it has several departments such as department of education where trainees undergo courses like B.Ed. in Special Education, a school with pre-primary, primary, secondary and pre-vocational departments, a counselling centre, resource room and speech therapy department.



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12. Working with Community Programme

The Regional Institute of Education (National Council of Educational Research and Training, New Delhi) Bhubaneswar is offering different innovative pre-service teacher training programmes for Eastern region of our country. It offers courses such as B.A.B.Ed., BSc. B.Ed., M.Sc. Ed, M. Ed, Two-year B.Ed., M.Ed. and Diploma Course in Guidance and Counselling. One of the innovative and demanding pre-service teacher education course is two-year B.Ed. Which is of four semesters. It has both theoretical papers as well as practical papers. One of the practical requirements of this course is Field Work with Community Programme having 8 days duration. The trainees are required to spend 8 days in a community and completely different activities.

The main objectives of the practices are:

- Acquaint the student-teachers with the factors working within the society or community i.e., knowledge of social realities.
- Develop the dignity of labour among student-teachers.
- Arouse their interest in the social and economic reconstruction of the country.
- Make the student-teachers aware with the educational problems, needs of the society and prepare them for sustainable development.
- Develop the personality of the student-teachers through community services.

The student-teachers involves in different activities like Study of the nature of community participation in a secondary school, survey of community resources for participation in scholastic and co-scholastic activities of a school educational survey of a slum area, report on social customs, traditions, and superstition, survey of a village/town with at least 20 households in order to study the socioeconomic and educational status of the villagers, Study of wastage and stagnation in local primary schools, Study of an area in regard to consumption of electricity and water and suggest remedial measures, Tree plantation programme in the campus/nearby village, Survey of parent's attitude towards education of their children, Organization of non-formal education centres for dropouts and out of school children in a locality, Organization of campus beautification programme, Identification of problems of parents with respect to education of their children, Aids awareness, electoral awareness, road safety, human



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rights, women rights etc literacy programmes in the community, Cleanliness drives in the community and awareness about its needs, Developing healthy food habits among the community members, Training of community in some simple vocations for self-employment, Action research on local problems in consultation with the community, Micro – planning exercises for assessing the educational status of the community, Establishment of peace-committees and making them functional effectively , Critical review and implementation of RTE act (2009), Assistance and working with local community in actual relief work whenever needed, Training of community in first aid, Exploiting the community resources and finding means and ways of using them for school etc.

- **In 2019-20**, Kalupadaghat village of Chilika block, Khurda had been taken as the venue for the purpose of field work activities. This exposure made the student-teachers to understand the Social, economic, cultural and educational pattern/status of the village. All these activities helped in providing input to students, teachers, parents/villagers for the over-all development of the educational status of the village. It created awareness campaign on literacy, gender equity, RTE, child rights, AIDS, superstition, dogmas, etc.
- **In 2020-21**, the institution decided to do the WWC programme at RIE campus due to COVID-19 pandemic situation. Various kind of activities such as orientation workshop of student-teachers for organization of programme in local community, Swachh Bharat, Prabhat pheri and different awareness programmes were done by the student teachers.
- **In 2021-22**, Institute had decided to organise this programme at Kalupadaghat village of Chilika block, Khurda. Student-teachers were engaged in various activities like Identification of problems of parents with respect to education of their children, Aids awareness, electoral awareness, road safety, human rights, women rights etc literacy programmes in the community, Cleanliness drives in the community and awareness about its needs, Developing healthy food habits among the community members, Training of community in some simple vocations for self-employment etc.





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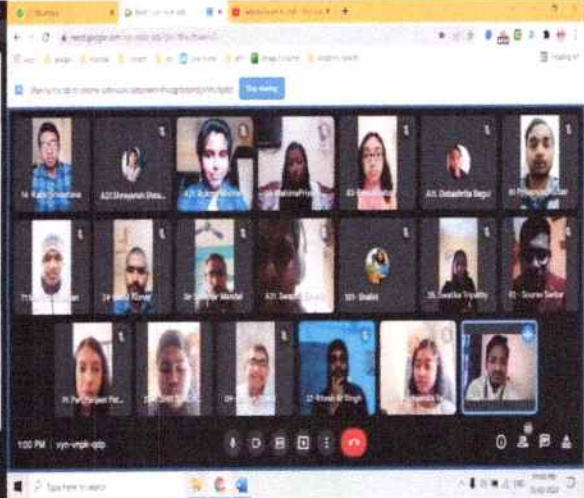
As school is a miniature community, and a big gap is found between school and community. Mutual exchange and sharing of resources and facilities between the two is essential for national development. The student-teachers need to have knowledge and awareness about the community and neighbourhood and the relationship between school and community. Considering the value of relationship between school and community and the facilitating role of teachers in this, the curriculum has provision for fieldwork with community. This programme aims at enhancing their ability to enlist community support for school and contribute for the national development and acquainting them with social realities, developing dignity of labour among and prepare for sustainable development.

13. Multi-Cultural Programme

To experience school activities in totality i.e. awareness about the functioning of school and its relation with neighborhood and development of insight into the role of a teacher and learner as a preliminary exposure activity the student teachers have to experience school activities. The student teachers will engage in reflection and sharing sessions. The reflection reports need to be submitted by student teachers highlighting the school objectives, processes and their reflection. In order to provide school exposure in various cultural backgrounds of the society to the student-teachers, they are placed in different type schools on rotation during the multicultural placement programme. During their placement in these schools they are required to conduct certain activities/ assignments. These activities are (i) learning of teaching-learning process through observation of lessons taught by regular teachers in the school. (ii) observation and collection of data about school's processes i.e. day to day activities of the school, for example, working of the library, process of organizing other curricular activities, functioning of laboratory and above all the school management (iii) development of sample unit plan, lesson plans /concept map and lesson note (vi) conducting case studies in the school. Fifty Marks are allotted for the above assignments that are internally evaluated as a part of the university requirement.

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14. Internship in Teaching Programme



The Institute is offering different innovative pre-service teacher education programmes for Eastern region of our country. It offers courses such as B.AB.Ed., B.Sc. B.Ed., M.Sc. Ed, M. Ed, Two-year B.Ed., M.Ed., Diploma Course in Guidance and Counseling and Diploma in Science Education which will be running in the Institute from this year. Some of the programmes in the Institute which are integrated in the curriculum are of vital importance. Internship in teaching is one such programmes.

The internship is conceived as a professional learning bridge between the pre-service Professional preparation and teaching. It is an extended school-based placement in which student teachers (interns) are expected to consolidate their knowledge and experience across all facets of the role of the teacher in the school. It provides an opportunity to further develop skills in teaching and for interns to be mentored in preparing themselves as thoroughly as possible for their early experiences of teaching. For internship the student teachers are placed in different JNVs of eastern region of the country i.e. Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal and Odisha. In order to facilitate staged entry of student teachers in teaching, Internship in teaching is organized in three phases viz. pre-internship, internship and post internship. The pre-internship conference for student teachers, cooperating school heads, mentors and institute supervisors intends to orient them on the modalities of organization of the programme.

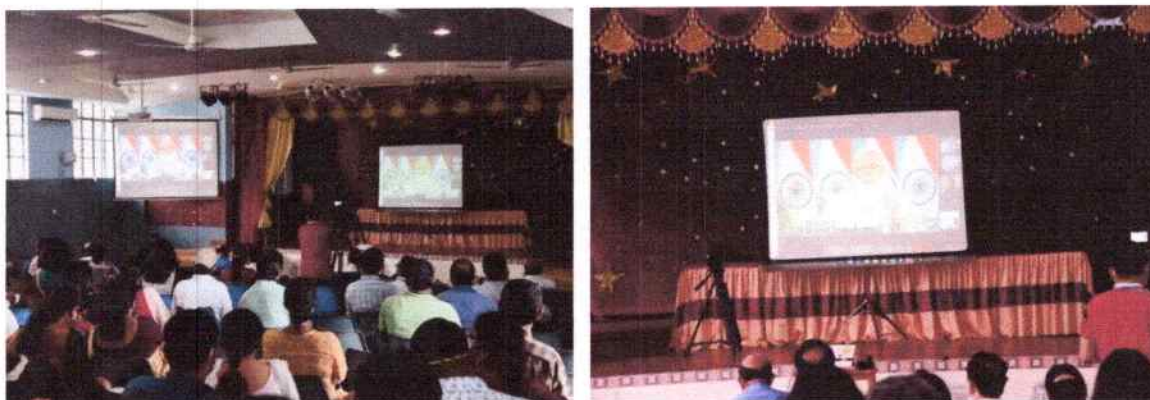
15. Shikshak Parv

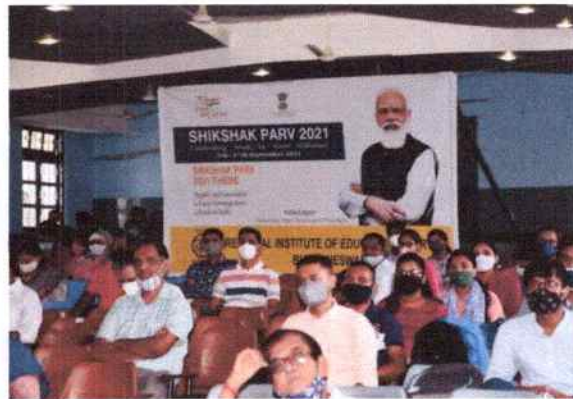

The theme of 'Shikshak Parv-2021' is "**Quality and Sustainable Schools: Learnings from Schools in India**". It is being celebrated to improve quality, inclusive practices and sustainability in the school education.


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An attempt was made to give wide publicity to the Shikshak Parv by sending letters to three local news papers of the state - The Sanmarg, The Times of India and The Samaj. Various Television channels were also requested to take the coverage of the Prime Minister's speech and other proceedings of the Shikshak Parv. Shikshak Parv - 2021

Regional Institute of Education, Bhubaneswar has been celebrating '**Shikshak Parv 2021**' since 7th September, 2021, which is being celebrated to honour the contribution of teachers across the country. Honourable Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on 7th September 2021 inaugurating the Shikshak Parv appreciated the noble contribution of the teachers during the pandemic. He specifically praised the contribution of 44 teachers who received the National Teachers Award for their outstanding contribution to the field of school education during 2020-21. Through a virtual conference organised by Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, the Prime Minister launched multiple schemes in the education sector like Indian Sign Language (ISL) Dictionary of 10000 words, Talking books, NISTHA 3.0, Vidyanjali 2.0, and SQAAF. The dictionary is launched by Indian Sign Language Research and Training centre of DPwD and has 10,000 words in it. Children and persons with hearing impairments can access this dictionary.

School Quality Assessment and Assurance Framework (SQAAF) has been launched which would work for pedagogy, curriculum, infrastructure development and inclusive education. PM Modi said, "For the development of any nation, education needs to be both equitable and inclusive. For the same, the country is including talking books and audiobooks as part of education. Based on UDL (Universal Design of Learning), an Indian sign language dictionary has been developed."

PM Modi also announced the launch of 'NISHTHA-3' training programs for teachers. He said that in this rapidly changing era, our teachers also have to learn about new systems and techniques rapidly. The country is preparing its teachers for these changes through 'NISHTHA' training programs.

PM Modi also said he has asked the Olympians and Para Olympians to visit at least 75 schools which could motivate the students in the sports and games.

Every day, through virtual mode webinars are being organised by Ministry of School Education, Govt. of India inviting participation of teachers, students and all stake holders which are attended by all faculty members of the Institute and D. M. School.

Since 7th September many initiatives have been taken by Regional Institute of Education, Bhubaneswar to make the public aware of the significance of Shikshak Parv – 2021. The visual and print media is involved in propagating the idea of significance of the Shikshak Parv and the National Education Policy – 2020. Webinars at the Institute level taking the different themes under NEP – 2020 are also being organized. To make the students aware of the New Education Policy, Essay Competition among the students on various themes of NEP-2020 was also organised. 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

16. Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign

The students' council recognizes the talent of students in academics. Following is a list of students who had topped in various programmes during the session 2021-22.


