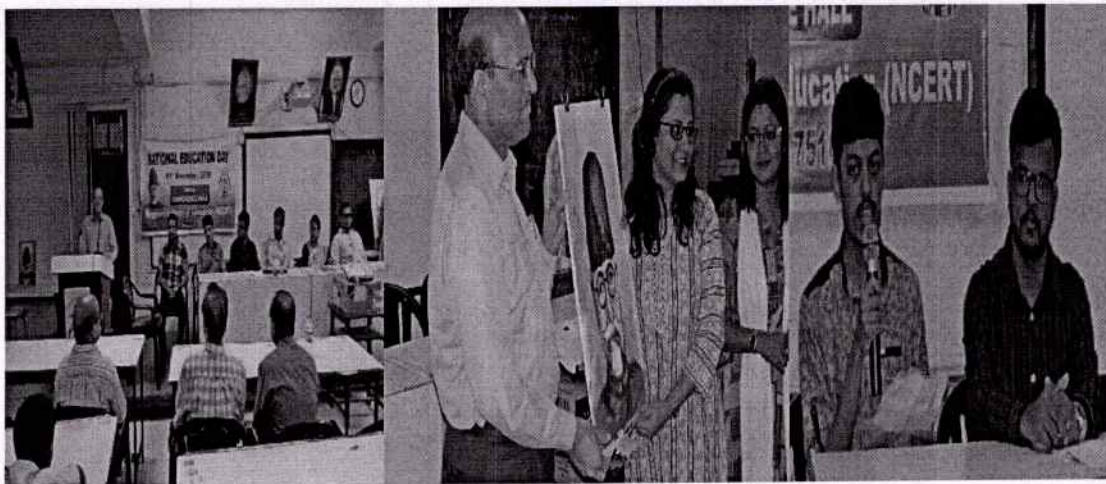

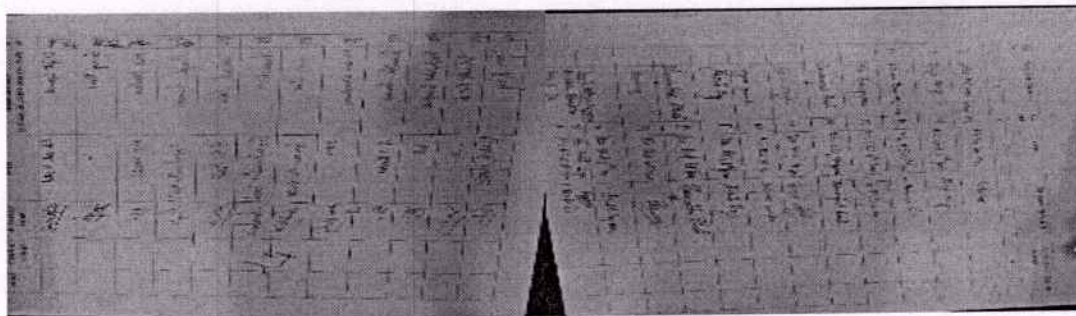

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**National Education Day (11.11.2017)**



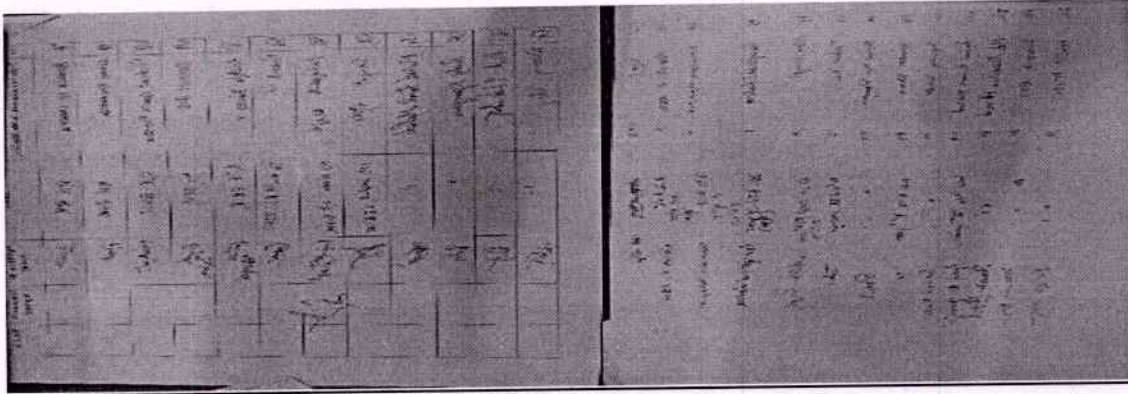
**Celebration of National Education Day on 11.11.2017**

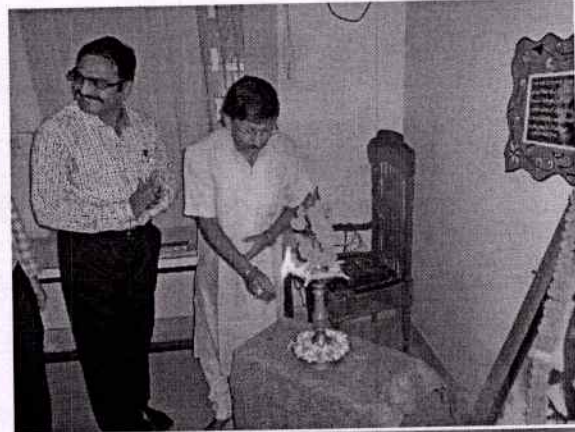
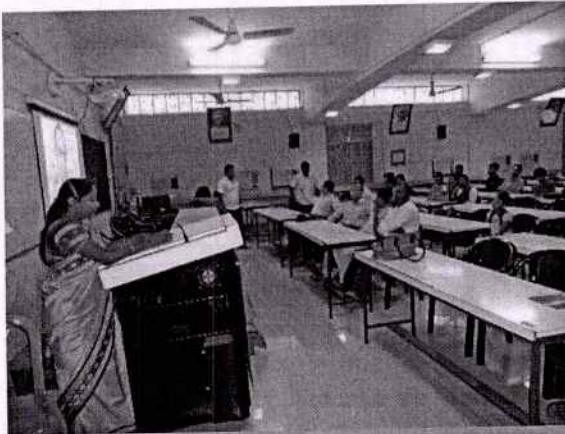

## Foundation Day (05.08.2017)

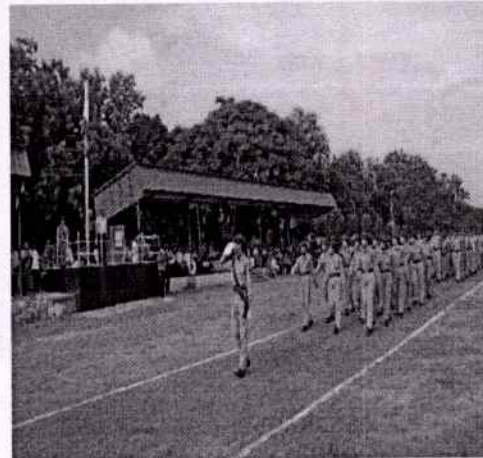

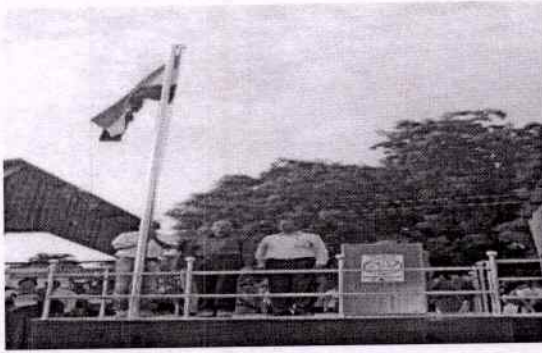

## Independence Day (15.08.2017):

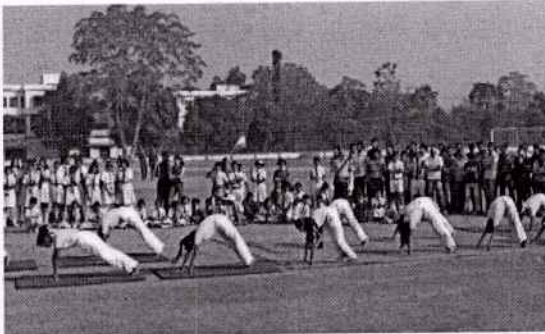
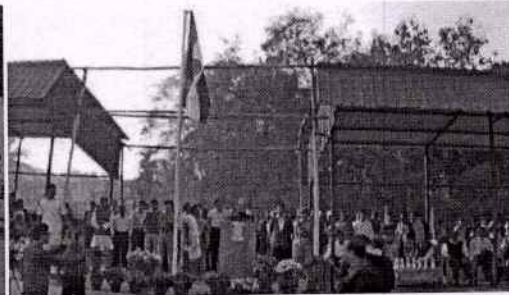

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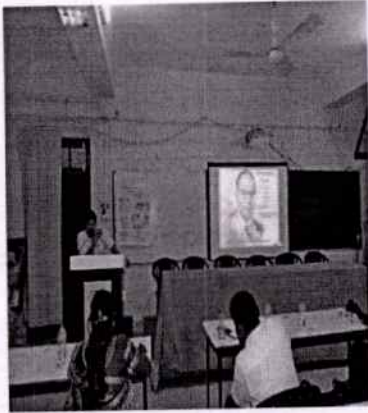
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### Birth Anniversary of Baba Saheb Bhimrao Ambedkar:

### Lecture on Ganita Sikhne aur Sikhane ki Padhati by Shri Hanuman Sahai Sharma:

Mathematics is a subject that has a wide range of applications in various fields. It is not only important for academic purposes but also for everyday life. According to him, there are four major steps that one can take to tackle a mathematical problem:

1. Students should solve problems after giving some time to build an idea/algorithm in mind in place of attempting it soon after reading the problem.
2. They should try to understand the problem and its context before attempting to solve it.
3. They should break down the problem into smaller parts and solve each part separately.
4. They should practice regularly to improve their mathematical skills.

Mathematics learning enhances problem-solving skills, critical thinking, and logical reasoning abilities. It improves analytical skills that can be applied in various real-life situations, such as budgeting or analysing data <sup>1</sup>. In addition, expressing mathematical ideas orally helps children to build communication skills. It can also form an important part of developing understanding of mathematical concepts and the ability to reason mathematically.

Applied mathematics is the application of mathematical methods to real-world problems with the dual goal of explaining observed phenomena and predicting new, as yet unobserved, phenomena <sup>1</sup>. Therefore, the emphasis is on both the mathematics, e.g. the development of new methods to meet the challenges of new problems, and the real world.

Here is a list of some real-life applications of mathematics that might interest you:

1. **Weather prediction:** Mathematics and supercomputers can help predict one of the most complex systems on planet Earth.
2. **Medicine:** Advanced mathematical techniques allow us to reconstruct three-dimensional images for solid objects like your head.
3. **Finance and banking:** Mathematics is used to calculate interest rates, compound interest, and other financial calculations.
4. **Computer science:** Mathematics is the foundation of computer science and is used in programming, algorithms, and data analysis.
5. **Engineering:** Mathematics is used in designing and building structures, machines, and systems.
6. **Cosmology:** Mathematics is used to understand the origin and future of the universe <sup>2</sup>.
7. **Epidemics analysis:** Equations can help us predict how the outbreak of a new disease might spread over time, and evaluate different responses.

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**Lecture by Shri Jagadananda Sahoo on Clean and Healthy India (15.09.2017):**

The talk could be concluded as the following major points

1. **Importance of cleanliness:** Cleanliness is essential for maintaining good health and hygiene. It helps to prevent the spread of diseases and infections. Cleanliness also has a positive impact on the environment and helps to reduce pollution <sup>2</sup>.
2. **Objectives of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan:** The Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, or Clean India Mission, is a country-wide campaign initiated by the Government of India on October 2, 2014, to eliminate open defecation and improve solid waste management and to create Open Defecation Free (ODF) villages. The program also aims to increase awareness of menstrual health management. The objectives of the first phase of the mission included eradication of manual scavenging, generating awareness and bringing about a behaviour change regarding sanitation practices, and augmentation of capacity at the local level. The second phase of the mission aims to sustain the open defecation free status and improve the management of solid and liquid waste, while also working to improve the lives of sanitation workers.
3. **Achievements of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan:** Since its launch on October 2, 2014, by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, approximately 6 crore toilets have been constructed under Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, around 300 districts, 3 lakh villages and 10 states/Union Territories have been successful in eradicating open defecation. India's total sanitation coverage today is at 76 per cent up from a mere 39 per cent in 2014. By achieving the lowest open defecation-free status in 2019, India achieved its Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 6.2 health target in record time, eleven years ahead of the UN SDG target of 31 December 2030.
4. **Challenges faced:** The Swachh Bharat Abhiyan has faced several challenges, including lack of awareness, inadequate infrastructure, and insufficient funds. The program has also faced

criticism for being more focused on constructing toilets than on ensuring their usage and maintenance. The second phase of the mission aims to address these challenges and sustain the open defecation free status.

5. **Impact of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan:** The Swachh Bharat Abhiyan has had a significant impact on the lives of people in India. It has improved the health and hygiene of millions of people, especially women and children. The program has also created employment opportunities for people in the sanitation sector. The Swachh Bharat Abhiyan has also helped to raise awareness about the importance of cleanliness and hygiene among the general public.
6. **Future plans:** The Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is an ongoing program, and the government has several plans for the future. The second phase of the mission aims to sustain the open defecation free status and improve the management of solid and liquid waste, while also working to improve the lives of sanitation workers. The government has also launched several other initiatives, such as the Swachh Bharat Summer Internship, to engage young people in the mission.

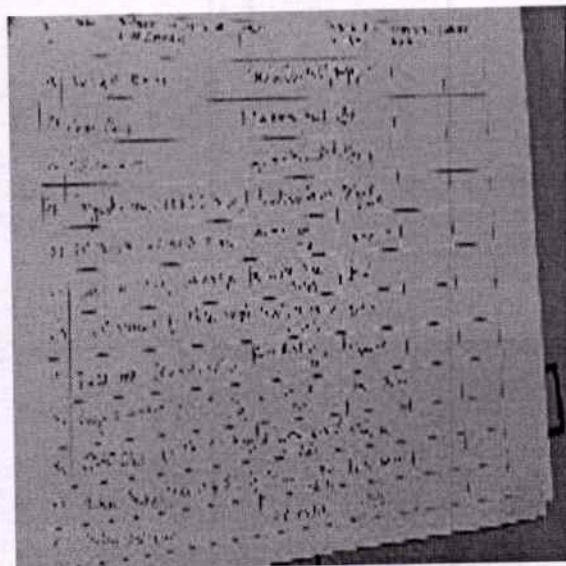
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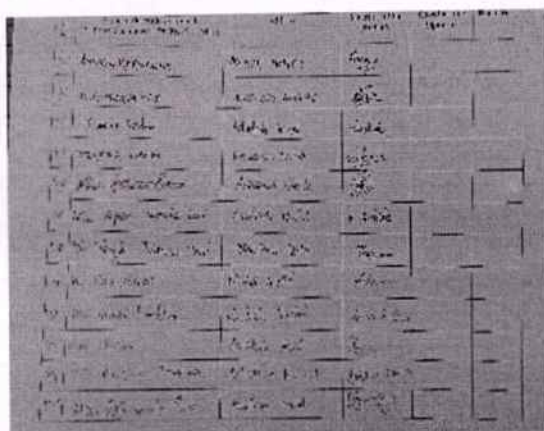

**A talk on Conservation of Bio-Diversity in India by Dr. S.P Parida (25.11.2017):**



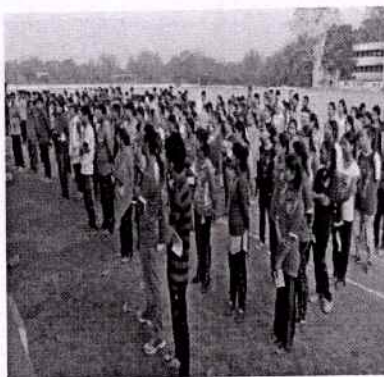
**The summary from the discussion could be analysed as:**

India is one of the **mega diverse countries** with 2.4% of the land area and 7-8% of the species of the world, including 91,000 species of animals and 45,500 species of plants, many of which are endemic. The country has a rich ethos of biodiversity conservation and traditional knowledge systems, which have given rise to informal and localized in-situ conservation. The Government of India has taken several steps for conservation of biodiversity, which includes survey, inventions, taxonomic validation, and threat assessment of floral and faunal resources; assessment to develop an accurate database for planning and monitoring as well as conservation and protection of forests; establishment of a protected area network of National Parks, Wildlife Sanctuaries, conservation, and community reserves; designating Biosphere Reserves for conservation of representative ecosystems; undertaking of species-oriented programs, such as Project Tiger, Project Elephant, Project Dolphin; complemented with ex-situ conservation efforts.

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**Field Work with Community for B.Ed-IV Semester (5.03.2018 to 11.03.2018)**

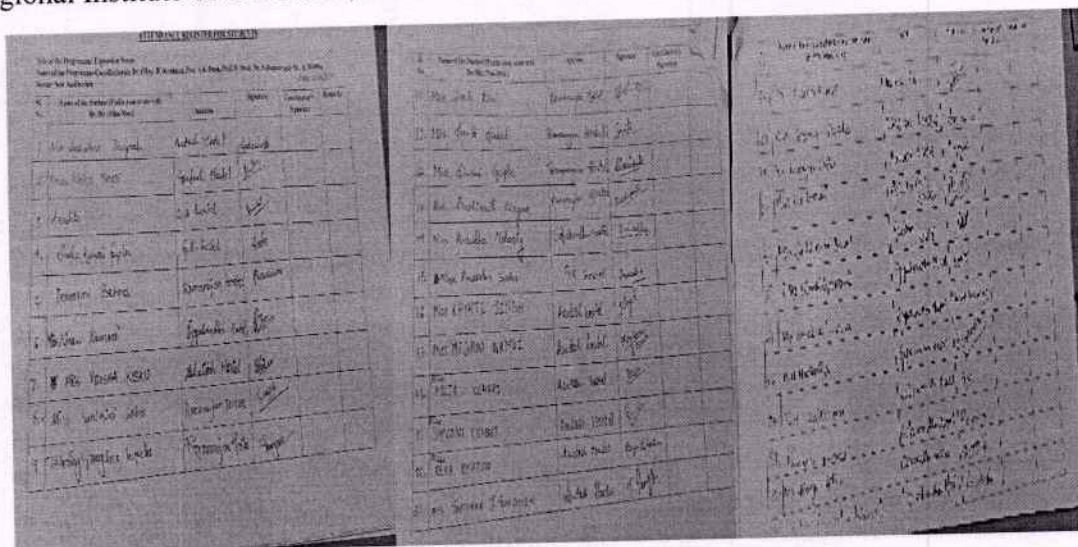

Since ancient times various scholars had made significant contributions to mathematics including Aryabhata, Brahmagupta, Mahavira, Bhaskara II, Srinivasa Ramanujan, etc. At a very young age, Srinivasa Ramanujan showed signs of an unfolding genius, and his contributions regarding fractions, infinite series, number theory, mathematical analysis, etc. set an example in mathematics.

### International Mother Tongue Day 2020-2021

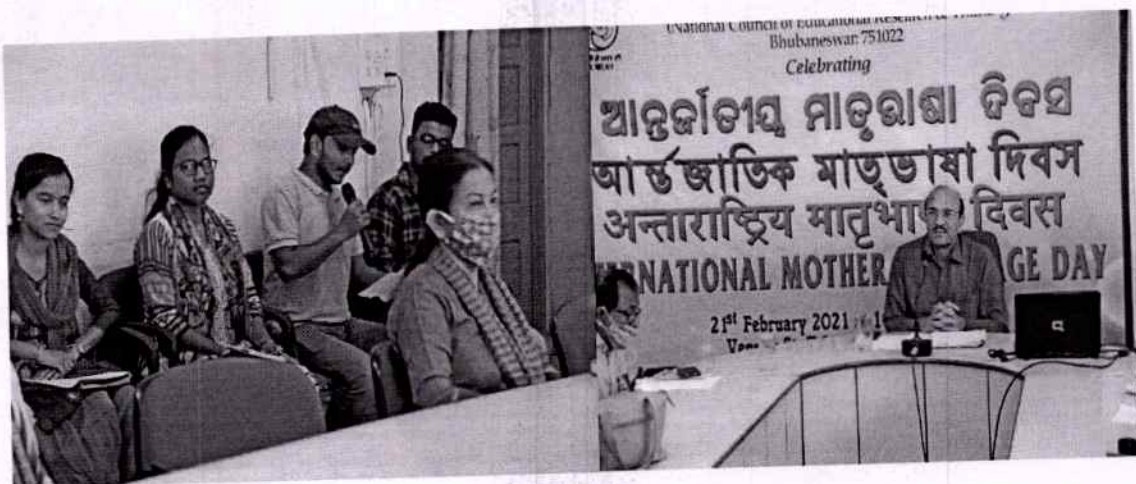

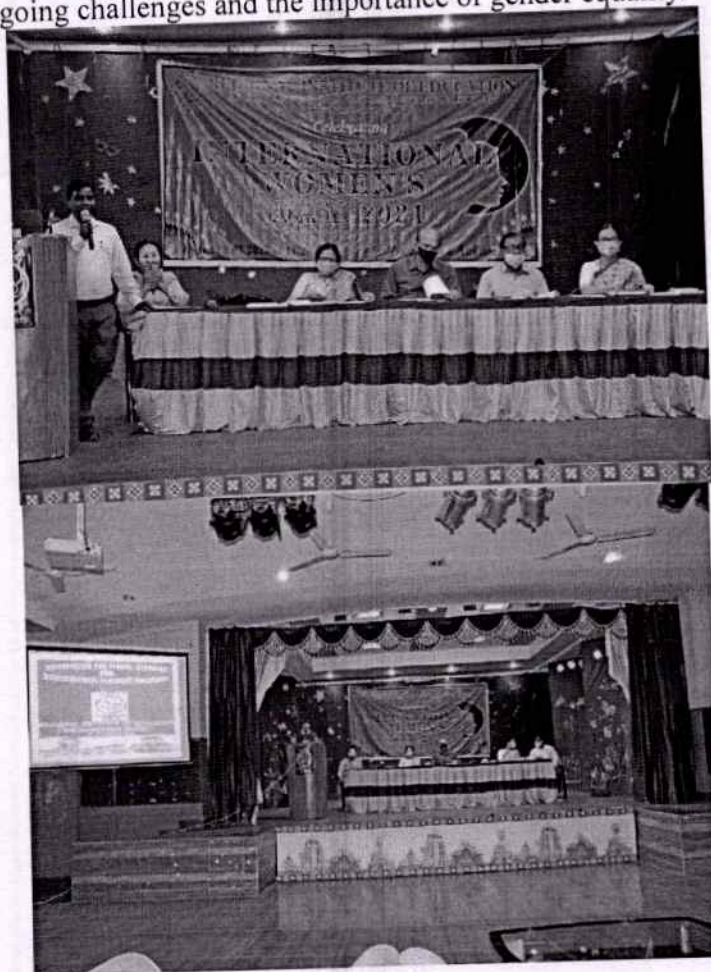
### **Celebration of Republic Day 2020-2021**

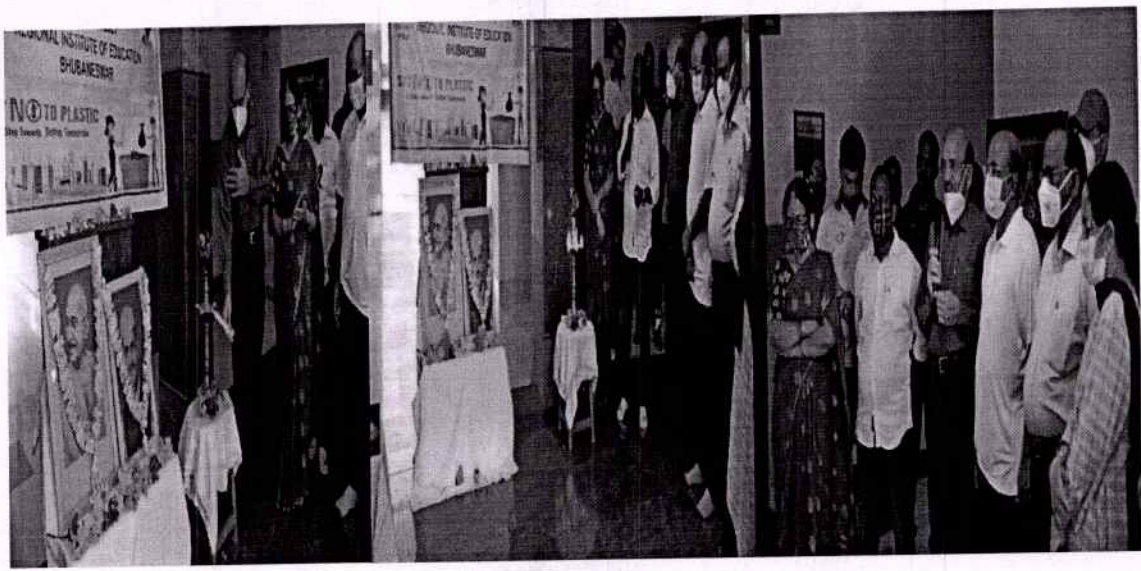

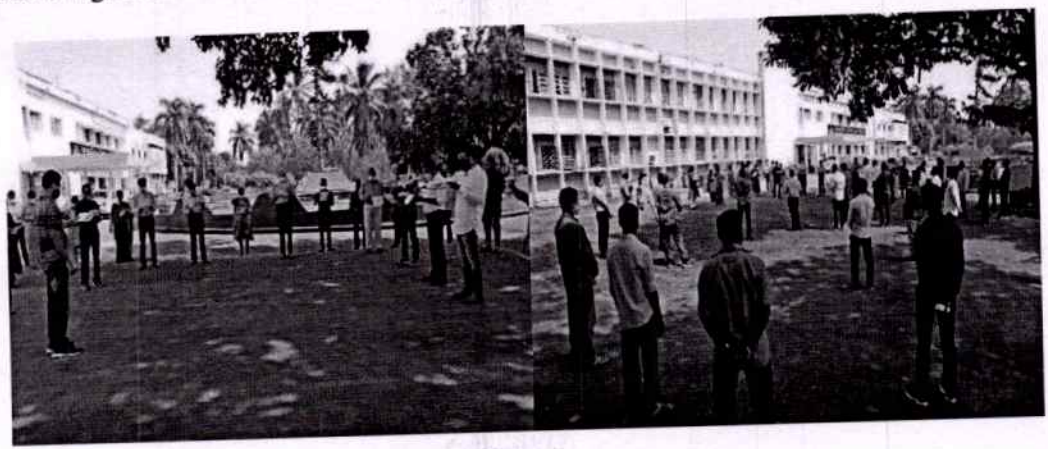

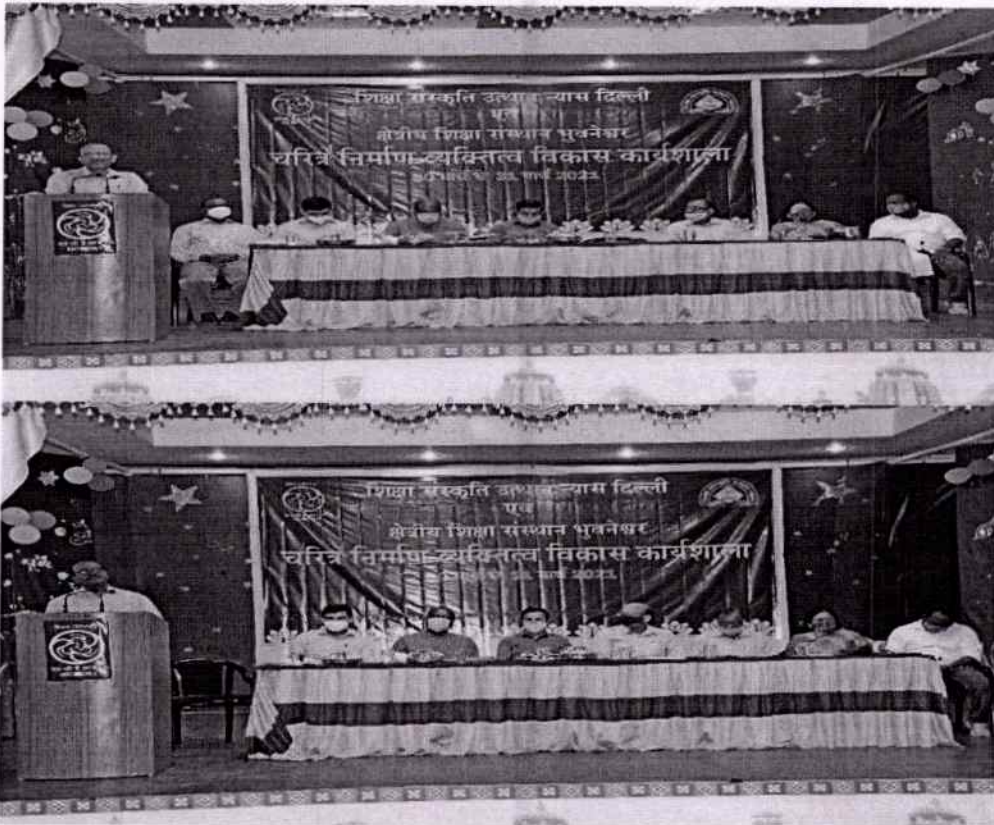
**National Unity Day and Vigilance Awareness Week 2020-2021**


**Working with Community of Semester-VIII, B.A B.Ed.**
